

Open Brush

1. OPEN BRUSH (VR PAINTING) — QUICK BEGINNER TUTORIAL

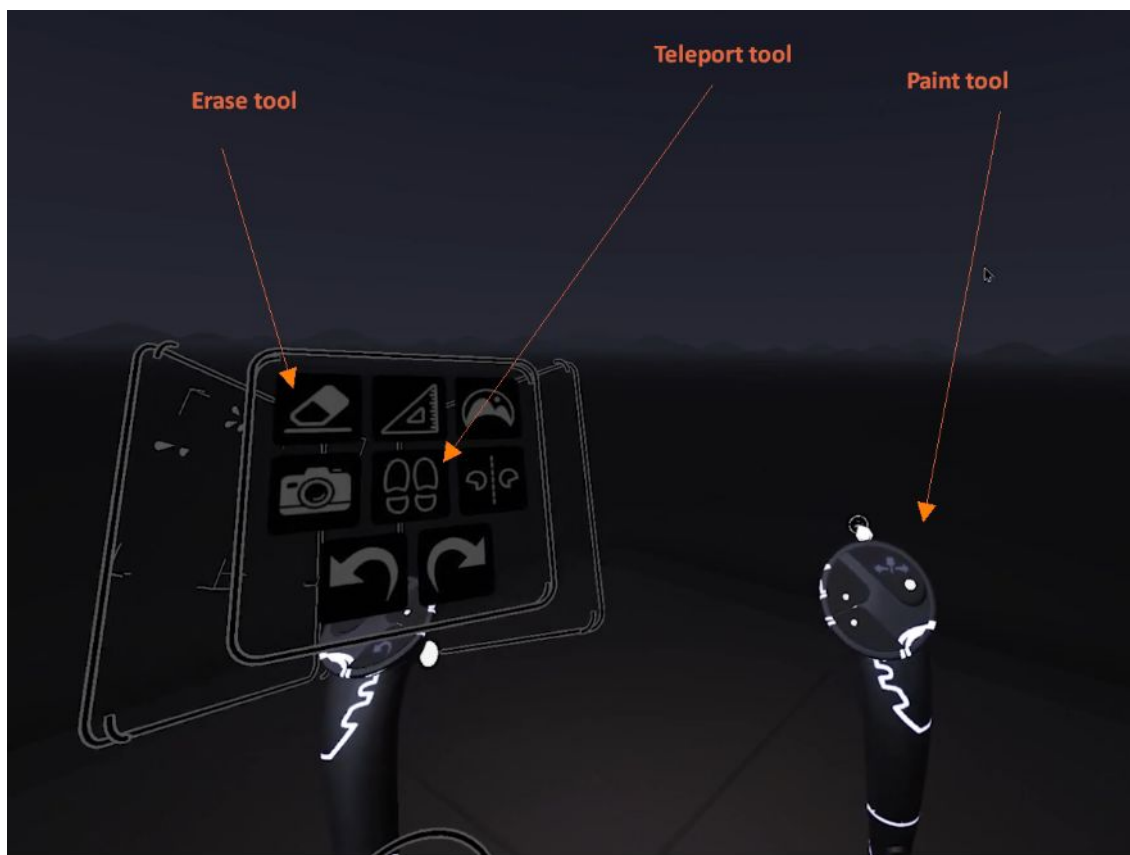
Open Brush is a free virtual reality painting app (originally based on Tilt Brush). It lets you create 3D art around you using motion controllers.

Here's a simple step-by-step guide to get started

2. GETTING STARTED

Put on your VR headset (like Meta Quest, HTC Vive, etc.) and Launch **Open Brush**. You'll appear in an open space (your "canvas"). You paint **in the air around you**, not on a flat surface.

3. BASIC CONTROLS



You have two controls with many palettes

Each controller has simple functions:

- **Trigger** → Paint / draw
- **Grip button** → Move the world (grab and reposition space)
- **Joystick / trackpad** → Teleport or rotate
- **Menu button** → Open tool/settings panel

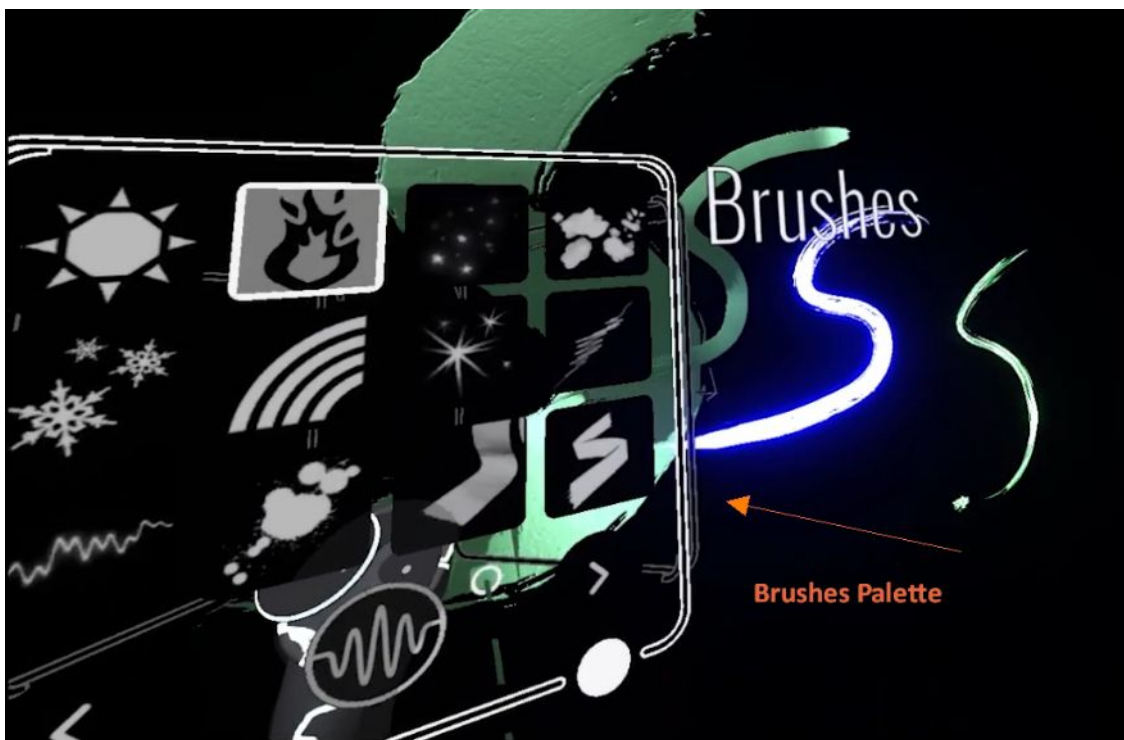
Tip: If you feel lost, look at your controller—Open Brush often shows hints.

4. . CHOOSING BRUSHES

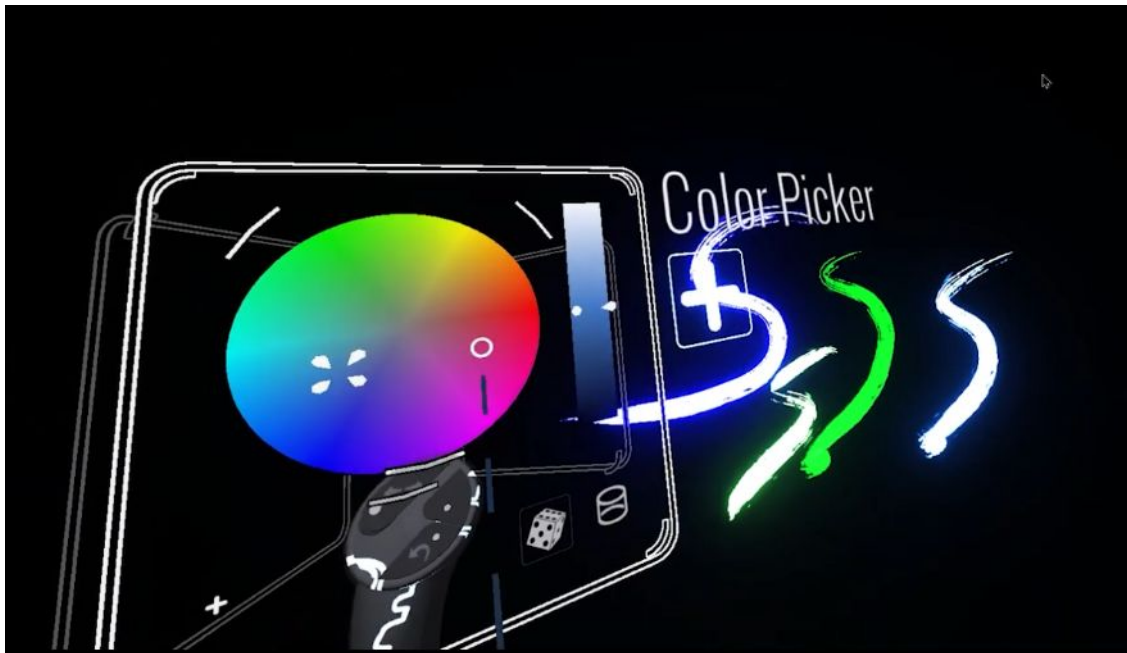
Open the brush menu:

- Pick from different brush types:
 - Ink (simple lines)
 - Light (glowing strokes)
 - Fire / smoke / particles

Each brush behaves differently—experiment!



5. . PICKING COLORS



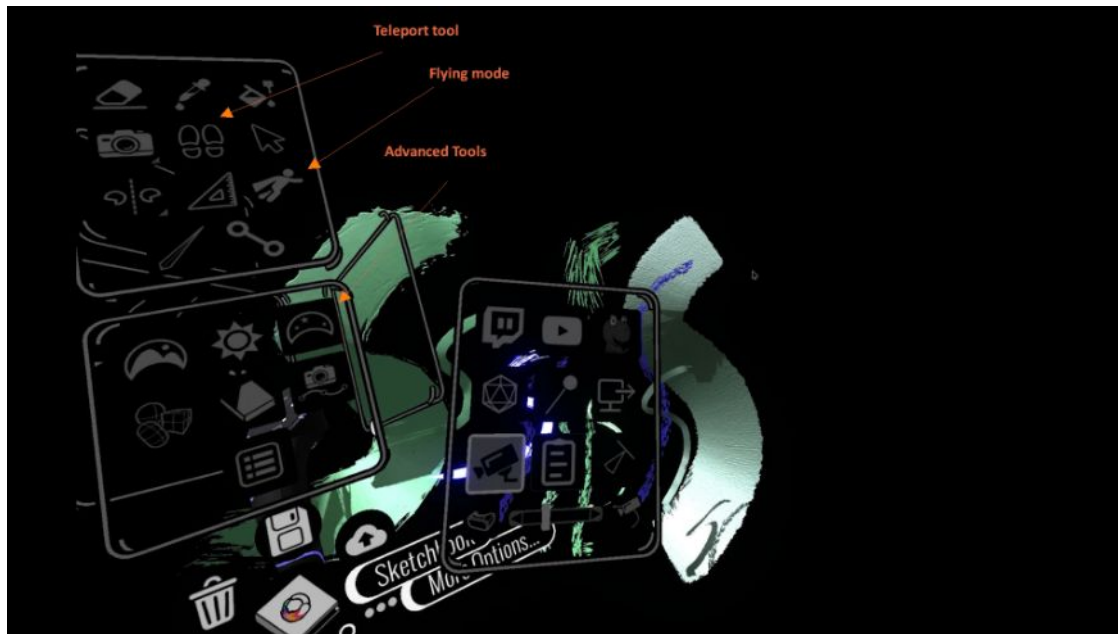
- Open the color palette
- Select any color or gradient
- Some brushes react dynamically to color changes

6. MOVING IN YOUR ARTWORK

You're not stuck in one place:

- **Teleport** to move around
- **Grab the world** to scale or reposition your scene
- Walk physically if you have space

You can even shrink your painting and hold it in your hand!



7. USEFUL TOOLS

Try these beginner-friendly tools:

- **Undo / Redo** → Fix mistakes quickly
- **Eraser** → Remove strokes
- **Straight Edge / Guides** → Make clean shapes
- **Symmetry tool** → Mirror your strokes

8. SAVING & SHARING

- Open the menu → Save your project
- You can export:
 - Images
 - Videos
 - 3D models
